



If you are yet to discover the benefits of our salt therapy room, within the new Belleair Country Club, let us explain a thing or two to you. Salt therapy is a natural remedy that involves the dispersal of pharmaceutical-grade dry salt in a comfortable, controlled environment. The room is set up to disperse these microscopic salt particles so they are both inhaled and land on the skin.

With natural anti-inflammatory and antibacterial properties, salt is used in this type of therapy for people of all ages and can help soothe and support a long list of skin, respiratory and lifestyle conditions including asthma, eczema/psoriasis, sinusitis, hay fever, colds and flu, stress, anxiety, general fatigue and more.

"Right across the Palm Lake Group, we have always taken our homeowners' wellness seriously – both on a physical and emotional level," says Jen Nichols, Palm Lake Resort Regional Sales Manager. "Here at Forster Lakes, we've offered wellness classes like yoga, tai chi, qi gong and more for a long time but our salt therapy room takes that focus on health and wellness up another level. I'm really excited to have brought salt therapy to our Forster Lakes homeowners first."

The benefits of salt therapy were first discovered in 1843 in Poland, where workers in underground salt mines suffered fewer respiratory issues. By chiselling and grinding salt, the miners produced micro-sized particles that were dispersed into the air of the mine and then inhaled. Once inhaled, the salt causes mucus to thin and liquefy, making it easier to dislodge and expel – along with pathogens, debris and pollutants.
