

Architecturally striking, our two-storey 281.59m² "Iluka" floorplan provides space, glorious space from the outset.

Downstairs, the hero is the huge master suite, strategically positioned at the home's rear, for ultimate privacy. With one of Palm Lake Resort's largest walk-in robes, there's an equally as vast ensuite, complete with full-sized bath and separate shower. The master suite also provides direct access to a private outdoor alfresco living area that substantially extends the master's reach, creating an indoor-outdoor sanctuary for homeowners' relaxation. 


